

Do You Practise Truth?



In the hurly-burly of every day it is easy to slip back where Truth is concerned, so every now and then I look over my past few months' living and take stock of what I have accomplished. I want you to do the same.

Do not, as you make this review, concern yourselves with the demonstrations over material things that you have been able to make, but confine your research to the spiritual side. What has Truth meant to you? What is your current consciousness of God? To what degree are you reflecting Him? Have you become more tolerant towards your fellowman, more generous? Have you learned the meaning of non-resistance? Have you, and this is important, more emotional control, and to what ends are you directing that spiritual zeal?

These are among the questions that I put to myself, and I go further. In my mind I enumerate the attributes of God, and of each one I ask myself to what extent I have reflected it; have I given but lip service, expressed this or that divine quality merely from a sense of duty or have I put my heart into it? Have I been a better friend, more loyal and constant in all my contacts, have the material manifestations taken second place in my thoughts, have I had greater faith? Only I can

tell! No one knows better than I do whether I have grown or not, whether I have now more courage and a higher trust than I had a while ago, whether my feet stand firmly upon a solid foundation from which I can dare to go forward fearlessly.

Neither you nor I can remain static. We have to progress, to face new tasks, to give ever more and more service, greater love and compassion, and as we advance spiritually we have to build up the quality of non-resistance.

It is God Who plants His ideas in our minds, but it is we who either develop them or allow them to lie unproductively. How often does one hear after something new has been discovered or accomplished, "But I had that idea as well!"? Of course! There is but one Mind, one Life, one spiritual concept, but it requires courage and perseverance to take hold of a thought and bring it to perfection as concrete physical form.

In all these years that I have been working with God He has left me to take the initiative. He has not preceded me, opening the door and saying, "Now, go through!" but He has become for me the spiritual idea behind the action that I was required to take in order to bring forth the greater good – progress, happiness or prosperity – that He desired to express through me.

Our hands, yours and mine, are God's workmen, and we can either sit back with them closed and idle while we retain the old consciousness of lack, discord and stagnation, or we can use them constructively so that He can release, by means of us, more of Himself in His visible world.

The hardest lesson that we have to learn is that, despite the love and loyalty that we have been expressing towards our fellowmen, we cannot and must not depend upon their loyalty or their friendship, and this is born in upon us because it is absolutely necessary for us to realise that, in all things, we have to rely wholly and solely upon the Spirit of God within ourselves. "Thou shalt have no other gods before Me, none, of any description.

While we continue to judge from the human point of view, taking into account appearances and conditions, it is very difficult for us to see from where our good can come, and not to look to persons for its manifestation: yet we have to realise that there is but one true Friend, but One on Whom we can absolutely count, the indwelling Spirit Who never in any circumstances can fail either you or me because He is the sum-total of all that is Love, that quality of the Father that will pour out for you, in an unending stream, whatsoever your hearts desire. That is the Spirit that speaks to you in the silence, saying: "This is what I have done for you, created for you; this is the consciousness to which you have grown, this is what you have earned." But you will not be sure, and again the same old questions will bombard you and you will ask, "How, and from where, can my good come, what channel will release it?" And the still, small Voice that answers will

say: "Am I not all knowledge? Am I not the Presence of Life? Is not every human being My temple, so that your hands are MINE, the vehicles of that All-power that can and will bring forth your good for you, never too late, but always on time?"

On countless occasions in my own life I have affirmed these things. I have told myself that God is the fulfillment, is in fact already fulfilled this day. I have tried to realise that His Presence IS the thing desired, that my very wanting it is the guarantee that it is already created for me, finished and done, and again and again doubt has crept in and I have asked myself, "Do you think He has failed? Could He possibly be too late? Can He be limited to some human entity for this?" It would be a sorry principle, surely, that required of us that we should pander to people, should be obliged to flatter and persuade in order to receive. After all, with the average human being it is always of "me" that he thinks first, it is ever the "I" that counts, until, having once touched – within himself – the hem of Spirit's garment, he finds the consciousness in which there is no distinction between "mine" and "thine" and knows that "Good is unlimited, and all that I have is yours." This attitude is justifiable only when you have attained a deep inner conviction that God is your all-sufficiency in all things, your health, happiness, peace, protection and prosperity; when you have realized that His Omniscience and Omnipotence can and will open every door to your good if you will put your trust in Him and disregard the human channels that will surely fail you, leaving you sick at heart, disillusioned, depressed and frustrated.

If as you review your lives you can say, "I look back with joy on my experiences, and even on the difficulties that were nightmares of reality until my awakened understanding dissolved them into the nothingness from which they came, even of these I can say that I thank God for them," you will have had a glimpse of that perfect Presence that is God.

Truth is the most wonderful thing in the world, and yet, until you have made It part of your very selves, until - not talking and reading It only – you live It all day long in your hearts, It will be of no value to you. "Not all who say unto Me 'Lord! Lord!' shall enter the Kingdom, but they who keep My Commandments." Of what use is it for you to read "The Path of Truth" regularly saying with easy satisfaction "Yes, yes, that is very nice, and it applies to me" if you then put it aside and carry on as usual? I – of all people – know that it is not easy to walk in the way that we should follow. I am a human being, no different from yourselves – sensitive, touchy, hurt by those who let me down where their loyalty and their love are concerned. I find it no easier than you do to keep my emotional balance, to be non-resistant and to do good to those who despitefully use me. Again and again I have to say to myself, "It serves you right!"

You must all learn not to depend upon man, who makes wild promises on the spur of the moment and then forgets all about them; your faith must not be planted in the shifting sand but anchored deep within the rock – the Rock of Ages

that stands four-square to all the winds (of change, adversity and chance) that blow.

You are here to grow in stature. You must make allowances for others as you would for children who know not what they do. If you live in tune with Truth, giving ever more love, friendship, tolerance and compassion, it is not important if at times you suffer disillusionment for it is by and through these experiences that you will come closer to Him and see His love taking the place in your lives of vacillating human affections and bringing forth for you, not only in the important things that you think to turn over to Him, but in all those smaller issues that mean so much to all of us in our daily lives. As you see this happening when perhaps you least expected it, do not forget "in all things" to give thanks for thereby shall more good come unto you.

If, during the time you are reviewing, you find that you have taken but a fraction of a step forward do not be dismayed; if you are trying to give as you have received, not only of material things, which are not so terribly important, but of yourselves, of some quality of the heart – love, sympathy, friendship – if you are willing to share your good and to offer it again even when it has been scorned, if you become not weary in well doing you shall surely reap your reward.

To those of you who feel that because of past bitterness, of tragedies that are hard to forget and to forgive, you cannot set the Spirit within you free I say that the yesterdays are

finished. Let, then, the dead bury the dead, and start afresh today!

Either in the easy way, or by travelling along the hard, rough road, you have to grow. You can kick against the pricks as much as you like, but you will hurt your own feet only; you can rise up against both God and man but it will avail you nothing, for you have no choice but to keep on! You must go forward for you are governed, whether you know it or not, by God's Law of Progress in all Good. "Behold, I will make all things new!" This is a promise made to all Creation. You cannot escape its significance, so start out in Truth this day. Practise honesty, sincerity and fidelity because these things are of God. Let your light so shine before men that they shall see the Truth enthroned in your hearts and have for themselves a beacon they can follow. Above all, "to thine own self be true and it must follow as the night the day, though canst not then be false to any man." Do not try to bluff yourselves, it will not work; if you live dishonestly, hypocritically, deceitfully you will but injure yourselves, NOT the other person. Search your hearts, therefore; see where perhaps you have fallen short if life is not all that it should be. Reverse your faults and failings, lift up your eyes to the hills; remember that you are not bondsmen, but the sons of God and the good – your good will come to pass.

Truth is not difficult, It merely asks that you be kind, tolerant and loving, and when you do this, at that instant,

the Presence of the Good begins to flow through you as whatsoever you need.

Go out into the highways and byways and let your light shine. Radiate His Love that does not ask what is wrong with this one or the other but falls equally upon the just and the unjust; be grateful in all things, for help received, for protection, for courage, for all that is God. Believe me, it is not alone the essence of Truth that is simplicity, its application is simple too, if you will take God into partnership, for He is Love, and Love is the fulfillment of the Law.

A Starting Point in Walking the Path



Where do we start when we want to change the conditions which are causing discomfort and unhappiness in our lives? There are circumstances and personalities in every individual's life which can be said to cause unhappiness. But are we

always going to depend on others for our happiness, health, harmony and prosperity as a child is dependent on his parents for all his needs? I don't think anyone would like this to be the case if he really stopped to think about it, but it is exactly what most people allow to happen. They get upset when another is short-tempered, inconsiderate, selfish or unkind. They criticize and even condemn the person concerned and make life thoroughly miserable for themselves. If you accidentally put your hand on a thorn, you would remove the thorn and allow the wound to heal and in a short time there would be no trace of the injury. Likewise, if an injustice is done, discern what it is, allow the effects to be dissipated and no trace of the injury needs to remain. But if the thorn is left in the hand, it does not only cause discomfort, it can become septic and even result in blood-poisoning. Likewise, we can harbor the resentments and fears we have towards others and they can grow and develop into the most monstrous problems.

So where do we start? Where or with what does everything start? With a thought. The thought is always coupled with some kind of emotion; a pleasant thought makes us feel good

and react favourably, an unpleasant thought does exactly the opposite. The answer would be to handle our unpleasant thoughts and feelings and then all would be well. But how do we do this? We usually start justifying ourselves or our actions as soon as we have done anything wrong; we try to cover up, look the other way, laugh or cry it away, withdraw into ourselves or become aggressive, without even starting to become aware of what we are doing.

The first step is therefore to stop and be still as soon as a discordant condition arises and to become aware of one's own thoughts and feelings; to discern the problem and to become objective and rational.

The second step would be to do what one can to change the condition. If you were the first one to be negative, admit it and try to put right whatever is possible to be rectified; if another was in the wrong, forgive and send out as much love and understanding as you can. In both these instances success is assured because you will be working in accordance with Divine Law. The result could be instantaneous or it could take much longer to manifest, but it will always happen at the right time, in the right way, at the right place in the right company.

What we have to remember at all times is that the Law works with absolute impersonal precision at all times. If we want to enjoy God's blessings we are not allowed to react negatively at all, not even for God's sake, and no matter how grave the other's misdeed was. We must develop the firm

assurance that every positive action will be rewarded with a positive reaction. It is often difficult to know how to express love to a person who has done something that has made you so angry that you have wanted to choke, or hurt you so deeply that you have felt like hiding away from the world and withdrawing yourself from all involvement lest it happened again. If it is impossible to "feel" love under these conditions try "thinking" love first. Remind yourself that "Love is the fulfilment of the law." This calms the emotions and a calm and relaxed state is very conducive to feelings of goodwill and love. I find this expressing of love very comforting, because it takes the responsibility of decision from my shoulders when I am in doubt about another's behaviour. I keep my mental and emotional equilibrium and send out love and God takes care of the rest. This is what makes it possible to understand these wonderful words: "Come unto me, all ve that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest."

What do you want to do in life – what is your aim? Ask some people this question and they will reply that they don't know – that they have never thought about it. These are the folk who are content to drift through the days, just earning a living, or maybe merely looking for pleasure. And probably many of them are bored. Your talent was given you to use not only in order to express yourself, but also for the benefit of your fellowmen.

Is there something you need for your comfort or well-being? If there is, make a picture of it in your mind, or keep a real picture of it somewhere where you can often look at it. Then work to obtain it – EXPECT to obtain it. God does not shower His gifts upon us like manna from heaven. We cannot sit down with folded hands, doing nothing, and say the Lord will provide. He helps us through our own efforts, for it is no part of His plan for us that we should be idle. If we want beautiful gardens it is no use to expect God to weed them for

us, or plant the seeds, or keep them watered. That is the part we have to play.

Room of Joy

Some people say that we are living in an age of anxiety but for some every age has been an age of anxiety. We persist with our fear and worry even though we are so often told how detrimental it is to our wellbeing, and knowing that we bring forth that to which we direct our energies. Those who are sensitive to their own condition feel the lowering of their state of mind and their vision of life.

Is this perennial condition of anxiety something mankind should simply accept? Is it just human nature or is there something we can do to rise above it? Perhaps more importantly, must those who are not afflicted simply learn to cope with the effect that the behavior of others has upon them?

This negation *can* be overcome if we are prepared to direct our will and the life-giving Force within us consistently and consciously towards the positive, even if at first it may be an almost artificial optimism, acting the part. Also, we can learn to relax our bodies and minds. It has been proven that relaxation blocks the entry of negative influences into our lives. Devoting time to relaxation, as we introduce to you at The School of Truth, is far better than giving time to your fears. Only a few minutes spent each day is enough to

establish the habit. We all live by habits, so we should try to make them good ones.

During our relaxations we invite Divine serenity into our lives. We do it by consciously accepting only that which is good, true, beautiful, sweet, peaceful and blissful. The Master exhorts us to "go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father." The homes of his society did not have the luxury of personal rooms, so clearly he means that we should retreat to an inner part of our mind, away from the clamour of the world and away from our worldly reactions to that clamour. With practice we can all learn to do this – to establish a quiet room in the mind and to fill it with sights and sounds that bring us joy, with images perhaps of a sunset, a river, a mountain, a private garden. In our special room we find it easy to contemplate the most beautiful aspects of life.

To this special Room of Joy we should retire in the morning before we rise and the evening before we retire, and as often as we can even for a few moments during our busy day. We can take with us into our Room an affirmation of God's presence. Psalm 91 has several wonderful affirmations, for example "He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High will say to the Lord 'My refuge and my fortress'." At first it may require discipline but soon it becomes second nature. We do not become dreamers, detached from normal life, but become more vital, more alert in consciousness.

There is a story of a man who wanted a genie. One popped up and said to him "I will be your genie and you can have anything you desire, but there is one condition - you must keep me busy all day long. I never stop working." So the man agreed, and asked the genie to plough his fields. In a short while all the fields were ploughed. Then the man asked that a wall be built all around the fields. Again in no time the task was completed. Then the man asked that all his farm sheds be rebuilt and the genie started work. At this point the man realised that he had a problem. How was he going to keep the genie busy all the time? He pondered and pondered his difficulty, but to no avail. So he went to see a wise man and explained his problem. The wise man thought for a while and then said "Ask the genie to dig a big hole in the ground and in it to erect a pole. Now when he is not doing something for you ask him to slide up and down the pole. That will keep him busy at all times, and out of mischief." So that is what the man did

Now the genie is like your mind, which is a tool that never sleeps. When it is not busy with a task let it rest in the Infinite. Direct it there before you go to sleep so that it does not disturb you but fulfills itself. Even during your relaxations you may direct it there so that there is a part of you that is always attuned to ultimate Reality, to God.

There is a humorous advertisement on television which shows how the housewife, unlike her husband, is able to do several chores at once. She is like the African mother who is able to carry an object on her head while holding a conversation, directing her small children, and doing other minor tasks. All the time there is a part of her mind making sure the object stays on her head. This is how we should be with God. We practice regularly to retreat into our quiet room and then to return to life's threshold.

Negation, like everything else, is built up by constant practice. It becomes a deeply entrenched habit. How often do you meet people whose entire reality seems to rest on anxiety? They seem to be happy only when they are worrying. The best way to destroy a bad habit is to replace it with a good one.

The opposite of fear is faith. We can make a habit of faith – to believe in God and constantly to practice our belief. This is not just an intellectual assent to the existence of God but living *as though* He exists, greeting each new day with love in our hearts, expecting each day to bring forth our highest good.

Each day we use our creative imagination, knowing that our consciousness creates our reality, our environment, and that our consciousness depends upon the thoughts and feelings that habitually occupy us. We need to soar above the mundane affairs of life. "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven."

We seek to perfect ourselves that we may be an inspiration and a blessing to all whom we meet. This is indeed the day that Lord has made. Let us be happy and rejoice in it.

- 1. We allow a period each day for meditation and communion with God.
- 2. We try to live every moment of the day with an uplifted consciousness, realising that our own positive prayers (thoughts and feelings) have all-power in our lives.
